We are delighted to be standing for re-election to Foley Park & Hoobrook Ward. We have worked tirelessly on many issues that have benefited the ward, including new roads and pavements, cleaner streets, road safety, better street lighting, lower council tax and community safety. We have consistently been strong voices for the ward and have achieved many good things from highway improvements and cleaner streets to economic regeneration.

Our major achievements over the last 4 years include:

- ◆ Led a campaign to improve traffic flows on the Hoobrook Island, with the opening up of a second lane of traffic on the Worcester Road.
- ◆ Provided new pavements for Tomkinson Drive, Hoo Road and the Forest Gate Estate off Wilden Lane.
- ◆ Successfully had Hoo Road resurfaced.
- ◆ Installed new gullies in Blount Terrace.
- ◆ Trimmed all the Lime Trees in Beauchamp Avenue, Blount Terrace, Northumberland Avenue and Neville Avenue.
- ◆ Completely resurfaced Clent Avenue.
- ◆ Successfully campaigned for over £1m additional funding from WCC to tackle traffic congestion on the Hoobrook Island.
- ◆ Provided new pavements for Shrawley Avenue.
- ◆ Completely resurfaced Stourport Road.

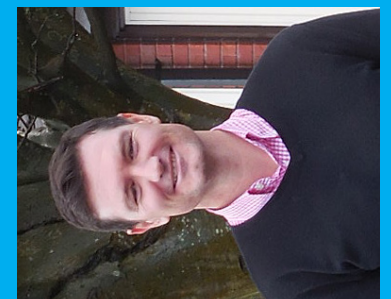
