

## Graffiti Clean-Up

Owen Cave has highlighted offensive and sexually explicit graffiti in the alleyway linking Comberton Place and Ray Mercer Way to the District Council for removal as a priority. ## New Pavements Needed For Hoo Road

Local residents have contacted your Conservative team, Cllr Nathan Desmond and Owen Cave, to raise concerns over uneven and worn pavements on Hoo Road.

Both Nathan and Owen have been out to investigate and have recommended to highways that a large section of pavement from Aggborough Crescent to Tutors Way is considered for a complete resurface.

Following construction of Auction Place, abandoned building materials and hazardous waste was noticed in a quiet residential cul-de-sac with children playing nearby. Owen has worked with the Association responsible and a quick clean up operation took place to remove all items from the street with a further view for the respective landscaping team being deployed to improve the area for residents.

Owen said, "This is not the action of socially responsible and considerate contractors and is a deprivation of our community which is unacceptable. I am pleased the housing association recognised this as soon as highlighted and took instant steps to remove the articles".
