- 3 Invest in our parks**  
 Work with parish and town councils to safeguard the future of our much-loved local parks and open spaces.
- 4 Working collaboratively with the Town Council**  
 Work hand-in-hand with our town council to improve local services important to you.
- 5 Scrap evening car parking charges and reintroduce free car parking**  
 End parking charges after 6pm; restore one-hour free parking to one car park in each of our three towns; and reduce the cost of annual car parking permits for over 65s.
- 6 Redevelop Worcester Street and the former Glades site**  
 We will demolish empty shops on Worcester Street in Kidderminster and support the development of housing and apartments here and on the former Glades site.

### Regenerating Our Town Centre

We support the economic regeneration of Kidderminster town centre.
