# My Plan

## for Bewdley and our rural communities

### 1 Continue to improve our roads and pavements

I have delivered six major schemes in this year alone, improving the look and feel of the area for residents and ensuring that Bewdley gets the investment it deserves.



### 2 Keep our Council tax one of the lowest in the Country

Worcestershire has one of the lowest Council Tax rates in the Country and I am a firm believer in a low tax base, keeping more money in the pockets of hard working people.



### 3 Protect our Greenbelt and countryside

Will continue to campaign against Labour's increase in Wyre Forest's new mandatory house building quota to 584 per year, up from 276, a 112% increase. This will encroach on local Greenbelt which must be defended.



### 4 Cracking down on crime and anti-social behaviour

Work closely with the Police and Crime Commissioner and local Police on a number of local issues from speeding, dangerous driving, rural crime and anti-social behaviour to make our community a safe place to live.



### 5 Back our farmers and rural communities

Backing our Farmers, supporting them in London and with motions at District and County level to write to the Government, urging them to reverse their decision on inheritance tax which will inflict irreparable damage to the Farming Community.



### 6 Support local communities and charities

Continue to support a wide range of local causes from play equipment in Bliss Gate, Bewdley Dementia Support, Nightstop, litter picking equipment in Far Forest and a large grant to clean the War Memorial in Bewdley plus support for Bewdley Festival and the Green Alliance Roadshow.
