I have had the privilege of representing residents on Worcestershire County Council since 2005 and residents of the Chaddesley Division since 2017. I have also represented you on Wyre Forest District Council since 2015 and as a Parish Councillor. During the last eight years I have had many local successes and I have championed the causes of local residents on a whole host of issues.

I have tackled highways issues throughout the whole of the area. Pavements resurfaced and secured funding for the pavement extension from Lower Chaddesley right up to the Primary School. Potholes are regularly reported and repaired. Roads resurfaced throughout the area, for example the Little Lane in Broome Village. Tackled the long standing verge issues in Park Lane, Rushock and secured an edge of carriageway scheme there.

I have lobbied the police to tackle speeding through the Parish, especially on the main A roads and lobbied the Police and Crime Commissioner for more enforcement.

I work tirelessly for you all year round, delivering my regular newsletter, regular Facebook posts, responding to all resident's phone calls and emails I receive, frequently out and about looking at issues and meeting with residents, as well as attending all 6 parish councils.

Outside politics, I work as a solicitor and have a young family. I am a trustee on 4 local charities including my passion - Scouting and am a season ticket holder at Kidderminster Harriers.

I am standing for re-election as I care passionately about the area and would like the honour to continue representing you.

What Marcus Hart has been doing for residents in Chaddesley Division



Tackled highways issues throughout the whole of the area.

Pavements resurfaced on the Wannerton Drive Estate, Blakedown, the A456 through Blakedown village, the A450 through Ismere, in Broome Village and at Briar Hill, Chaddesley.



Lobbied the police to tackle speeding through all our Parishes

Focussing on all of the main A roads across the division and in particular ensuring the A456 through Blakedown Village continues to receive speed enforcement and Stakenbridge Lane now has speed enforcement by the police motor bike.



Secured road resurfacing throughout the area

For example the Little Lane in Broome Village. Tackled the long standing verge issues in Park Lane, Rushock and securing an edge of carriageway scheme there and along Deansford Lane



Investing in new infrastructure

After seeking public opinion, I secured funding for the pavement being extended from Lower Chaddesley right up to the Primary School. This will allow villagers to access Rowberrys and the school safely on foot.

My plan for Chaddesley Division

1 Further investment for our roads and pavements

I am delighted that Worcestershire County Council continues to invest in roads and pavements. I am campaigning for further investment and am lobbying for pavement resurfacing works in Stakenbridge Lane and many other pavements across Chaddesley, Blakedown and the parishes.



2 Speeding in our Parishes

Speeding continues to be a major issue. I am actively campaigning for a speed limit reduction in Clattercut Lane at Rushock Wood and on Tanwood Lane, Chaddesley and at a number of other areas. I pledge to continue to ensure the police carry out speed enforcement on the main A roads and other community concern sites.



3 Flooding - A448

I am lobbying for a permanent solution to stop the A448 flooding in Chaddesley at the Fox Lane junction. In the first instance I have been promised additional gullies to increase drainage capacity on this busy main road.



4 Council Tax

I have served continuously under a Conservative led Council since 2005 where council tax has been kept under control. I pledge to ensure that under a Conservative Council, council tax will be kept as low as possible and we continue to be in the lowest quartile across England.



5 Flood alleviation schemes

In the rural areas, especially with more flooding events, more of our rural roads are being flooded and gullies are being blocked up with silt from run off. I am campaigning for even more money to be invested in flood alleviation schemes and basic gully jetting.



6 Minor Highways schemes

Residents have complained about water ponding in Station Drive, Blakedown, and I have been successful in securing an improvement scheme for this. I am lobbying for similar schemes across the Division.
